

Art exhibition at AES power plant this weekend

The CA 101 art show is open for its second and final weekend Saturday and Sunday at the AES Power Plant in Redondo Beach. The show was set up in the 650-foot long building that houses the shut down electric turbines. The show features works from 117 artists.

Redondo Beach's AES power plant will double as a museum again for a second weekend as 117 artists from 35 cities display their works around the vast interior.

CA 101 — which features various media and some large-scale pieces, including one that's 17 feet tall — is free and open to the public, said Nina Zak Laddon, a Redondo Beach artist and the exhibition's curator.

This weekend, June 15 and 16, CA 101 is open from 11 a.m. to 8 p.m. Saturday and 1 to 7 p.m. Sunday. On Friday, June 14, art critic Peter Clothier will lead an hourlong painting session at 4 p.m. for paying guests. (Anyone interested can register for \$25 at the art table).

Exhibition sponsors include the nonprofits Redondo Beach Art Group and Friends of Redondo Beach Arts, along with AES, CenterCal Properties and other local businesses.

This isn't the first time artists have taken over the waterfront plant at 1100 N. Harbor Drive. It's also hosted the Redondo Beach Art Group's Power of Art, featuring exhibits, music, workshops and more.
